



General Residential Driveway Permit Information

1. Inspection

The Community Development Department **MUST** inspect the framing and stone base **BEFORE** any concrete is poured, **MUST** inspect the stone base **BEFORE** any asphalt or brick pavers are placed.

Please call **(847) 357-4220** at least 24 hours in advance to schedule an inspection. Your **permit number** will be required.

Failure to schedule inspections may result in the forfeiture of your cash bond.

2. Restoration

All property damaged during construction is required to be restored to the satisfaction of the Village.

4" of Topsoil and SOD restoration is required on Village parkways.

3. Bond Refund

When construction is completed and all property is restored per Village requirements, send in the attached signed:

REQUEST FOR FINAL INSPECTION & APPROVAL FORM

This will initiate the **FINAL** inspection and return of your cash bond.

4. Specifications & Details

The attached residential driveway specifications and approved plans are made part of the permit. **Please contact the Community Development Department with specific questions before you begin any work.** No concrete, asphalt or brick pavers may be placed on a wet or frozen stone base.

For brick paver construction, a copy of the manufacturer's installation guide must be submitted with the drawings and permit application.

Note: All new or widened aprons must be constructed of concrete or brick pavers. The mixing of materials is not allowed.
