



BUSINESS SAFETY & EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

The Elk Grove Village Fire Department offers various safety training courses tailored for local businesses. These programs help ensure employees are prepared to respond to medical emergencies in the workplace. For more information or to schedule a training session, please contact the Fire Department.

First Aid - First aid training equips individuals with the essential knowledge and skills to provide immediate assistance to those who are injured or suddenly ill, until professional medical help arrives. The primary goal of first aid is to stabilize the situation, prevent it from worsening, and potentially save a life. This course pairs nicely with CPR.

Class Cost & Duration: First Aid Only \$50/person, 3 hours long. First Aid & CPR \$90/person, 5 hours long.

Bloodborne Pathogens - Bloodborne pathogen training helps employees understand the risks, prevention methods, and proper procedures in case of exposure to blood or bodily fluids in the workplace. This training equips individuals with the knowledge and skills necessary to protect themselves and others from bloodborne pathogens

Class Cost: \$25/person Class Duration: 90 minutes

Stop the Bleed - Stop the Bleed is a national awareness campaign and call-to-action that encourages bystanders to become trained, equipped, and empowered to help in a bleeding emergency before professional help arrives. Through the Stop the Bleed course, you'll gain the ability to recognize life-threatening bleeding and intervene effectively. This class includes live instruction and hands on practice.

Class Cost: \$25/person Class Duration: 90 minutes
